She is saved and teaches a children's program at a church about 30 minute subway ride away. It will be great to spend time with her, too.

This Sunday our church is taking a hike up Buraam San (san is mountain in Korean). We will be fellowshiping with one another and evangelizing.

Pastor Steve has a vision for sketchboard evangelism at Lotte Mart, a walking street, and Homever, where they are building an "English corner". This park is being built for the sole purpose of learning English! A great thing for the kingdom of God and the Gospel!!

Thank you for co-laboring with me in the Gospel. It's a privilege to be here and serve our Lord, Jesus Christ!
