Greetings from Tirana, Albania. Eurocon 2009 has just ended and I think that this verse from Luke 24 sums it up perfectly. It was a wonderful time of refreshment and edification where the Word didn't close (even until 1:30am on most nights). We have come back to Tirana with focus and excitement to see what God has in store for this upcoming season.

Sandy and I went to Budapest looking for specific answers to prayer. We received it. We were looking to God to reveal to us what His will for us is in this upcoming year, whether to stay on the mission field or not. As many of you know Sandy is pregnant and we want to be in God's perfect will. Going to America would be the logical choice, but as so often is the case God chooses to defy human “logic” for His purpose and His glory. We feel that God has us in Albania for another season and are very excited to see God work in this church and city.

The weather is warming, more people are on the streets and that opens the door for more avenues of evangelism. The sketch board was brought out for the first time last week and we plan on doing some open air preaching this summer. People here are very open to the gospel and we are here to tell them. Please pray for the harvest here, and for God's leading in which avenues to use.

Sandy and the baby are both doing well and are very healthy. Sandy is amazing. The trip to Budapest was 28 hours long by van, taxi and train and she did it with never anything but a smile on her face. Sandy is still doing children's Bible club with two girls of the church on Saturday afternoons, please pray for her strength and continue to pray for her and the baby's health. Little Abigail will be here in late June or early July, so we will miss the international convention this year but are looking forward to visiting in August.

We have recently started another semester of Bible college. My father is teaching three classes live. He is a very gifted teacher and enjoys it, so please pray for his study time. Sandy and I are also taking a few classes by extension on DVD.

Thank you to all who pray for us and support us. You are a vital instrument to this team and you are on our hearts and in our prayers. Please continue to pray for the church here.
