There is no time to be bored or passive. We are encouraged to think and pray about missions, neighboring countries, and to make steps by faith toward it. We have an awesome Pastor that lays down his life for people God. It is an honor to serve under his leadership. Pastor Fuad and Baku church are gifts from God to us.



Let us share briefly just about the project we're implementing in the Bible college. Erika and I started it a couple of years ago. That is an awesome innovative project that has an objective to motivate, encourage, and inspire students to draw near to God, have unity and interaction as family members in the Body, support mission work, and become missionaries, and get more Bible college students. It is called MISPO (mission points). Students collect points during the semester and hopefully by the end of 2009 we will have those who collected enough Mispo to qualify to attend the Eurocon in 2010. Each manat (local currency in Azerbaijan) spent in the church brings to a participant 5 'Mispos'.



Sources for Mispo:

- Bible college classes (each class is up to 20 Mispo),
- Grace Corner Café (homemade food purchased for 1man=5 Mispo),
- Supporting Azeri missionaries financially (each manat = 5 Mispo)

There are other projects within the MISPO called "Person of the week", and "Mispo Bulletin". It is fun to see students enjoy it and grow.
