We were so grateful to have a group of nearly 20 pastors from Ghana, Liberia, and America, with us in Takoradi for four days in January. Pastor Scibelli, GGWO Missions Director, was among them. We had a great time of fellowship with the church in evangelism to new areas such as; New Takoradi, Shama, Daboase, and Sekondi. Pastor Scibelli's messages of encouragement, has encouraged a great revival in our hearts.

At our annual Ghana Conference in Ashaiman, (where we served our first 2+ years.) we had the honor of having Pastor Tom Schaller, the head pastor of GGWO, as our main speaker. His messages and the pictures he drew thru scripture and illustration on "The Two Goats" from Lev. 16:7-10, as well as the Pastor's session on 1 Timothy 1 was awesome! Pastor Scibelli's message on "The Book" from Nehemiah 8 motivated and encouraged the nearly 3,000 Greater Grace Church members and pastors from Ghana, Ivory Coast, Togo, Burkina Faso, Niger, Nigeria, America, and U.K. Just as important to us was the personal time we had with Pastor Schaller. His wisdom and insight through serving for more than 25 years on the mission field with his family is invaluable to us and we cherish his insight.

The conference continued in Togo. We had a great time with the leaders. They have done such a great job of continuing the work of the faithful GGWO missionaries, Pastor Luigi & Isabelle Palmieri, who served there for more than 10 years and are now preparing to begin a new work in Benin. Pastor Scibelli's leadership session messages about the need for us to receive and give edification to build us up (Acts 9:31) and knowing the "pattern" that we build our ministries in GGWO upon (1 Cor. 4) were of special encouragement. I also enjoy a change in cuisine... oh the French and Lebanese food!!!

NEW OUTREACH AREAS – Daboase, Shama, New Takoradi. I have been visiting the areas where our disciples and Bible College students have started "churches". They are all at various stages of growth; from a handful of people sitting in a seaside fishing village, to a group in "the bush" under a tree meeting to study the Bible. It is great to see God's hand at work. Please pray for these men who are taking steps of faith; Wilson, Abeku, Daniel and others. Abeku shares Gospel tracts just below the steps of Shama Castle (the oldest castle in Ghana), Renee Beland shares the Gospel in New Takoradi as a young man reads a tract and another fisherman listens, as he repairs his net (Matt 4:18-22).
