News from Emile Kisimba in the Zambian Copperbelt February 2010

It is true that when God calls, He performs as well. He consistently works within and through us in His calling. His work never stops to produce fruits as we agree to walk with Him. As a result, our lives speak to people and draw them to us and to the ministry.

This is happening here in the field here in the Copperbelt province of Zambia. Because we trust Him for His work, He puts around us right people to disciple for the continuity of His work.

When we moved to Kitwe from Ndola I had to rent a room. the first day that I met my landlord, who lives in the same compound with me, I saw on his forehead a huge black scar and realized that Mr. Juma was a Moslem (Moslems' foreheads hit the ground while praying and bruise their foreheads). Mr. Juma is a US dollar millionaire. He has a bad name in the City because he lends money in order to get it back after a month with an interest of 45 % more. People mortgage houses, cars and other goods when they are desperate to get money from him. Some fail to pay back, consequently their goods are confiscated. Mr. Juma's two children, Jaffari and Lukiya (six and four years old) like to visit my "chamber". I usually teach them how to pray when we share my food.

One day, I purposely gave Lukiya a tract gospel to take it home. After a while, Mr. Juma called me to meet him. As I approach his Veranda; Mr. Juma, a big man stretching in the couch, gives me a seat. After a short time of silence, he said: "I called you because I want you tell me about the Bible and Jesus Christ." After talking to him for almost ten minutes, he almost drops tear. He shook my hand and said: "keep coming to have Bible studies with me". Since then, I have been having Bible studies with him. He is really getting opened to the Word. We noticed that his workers and everybody go to him only when they are in need of money, but we see Mr. Juma like Zacheus in the tree and love him up. A week ago, Jaffari the older child told me that my Dad has stopped going to the mosque on Fridays and everyday early in the morning. Please, pray for him so that he can fully understand salvation through Christ and visit our church.



Bible College

We are half way this first semester of our Bible College. Our students are really fascinated with our teaching- the grace and finished work teaching. Two days ago one of the students told me that we are blessed to have this accurate information of the Bible. "I am now able to discover false teachings on T.V and Radio", he continues. When we teach, we always sense a Spiritual focus and a great atmosphere during the classes. The most and unique students are the ones from Chingola. They are very humble and lovers of the Bible. Few of them travel to Kitwe in the weekend to take other classes. It seems like the transport money has been a problem for the rest to travel to Kitwe on Saturdays and Sundays for the other set of classes. Our advise to them is to be faithful in the little (the one class that they attend home) and God will give them much. Let's continue praying for God's provision for their transport money.
