## News from the Field...

### Lima, Peru

As you read this, small groups of Peruvians are taking Applied Bible Doctrine, Biblical Psychology, Discipleship and Intro to Theology in the coastal cities of Lima and Trujillo, the mountain city of Huánuco, and the Amazon rain forest city of Pucallpa. We wish to provide much more for them, and to bring some of the key disciples to Lima for intensive training.

In the south of Lima, our involvement with the Addes School continues to provide fantastic opportunities. We recently ran a two-day camp for them, with 38 of the students taking part. Now they want us to provide a child-training retreat for the parents. Please Lord, many salvations!

Our mime team went out on Sunday afternoon to the municipal plaza, only to find that a local cell phone company had gotten permission from the government to have huge speakers set up with their sales booths in the center of the park. They had music and microphones for the salesmen. As I tried to decide what to do, with the mime team already painted and ready to go, the Spirit told me to ask the company to stop the music for 15 minutes. I didn't believe they would do it, but sent two of the mimers to ask. As I thought about where to go, I heard the man with the microphone announce that they would be stopping the music for 15 minutes for a mime production. He then proceeded to promote our mime with great vigor, and many people from all around the plaza and even from across the street began to gather. We brought up our little boom box, and when he heard the volume of our music, he held his mike up to our speakers so that now our music filled the whole area. When our guys had finished their three extremely anointed mimes, and David, our mime leader, started to preach the gospel, one of the men from the cell phone company walked the mike over to him so that all could hear. The results were beautiful salvations and a mime team that knows more than ever that God is in their work!

He is indeed blessing us. Come and visit us if you can for our August 2-5 Missions Conference followed by a trip to Machu Picchu for an Inca Rap.
