News from the Field...

Nepal

We were invited to visit Dolakha district at the border of Tibet. At the end of May Ananta, his son and I took a 150 km bus ride there. The roads are very rough, so after ten hours on a bus and a two-hour walk up the hill we reached our destination. 40,000 people live in the area but we visited only one small village. Most of the people are Hindu and idol worshippers.

The next day our brother Ananta invited his relatives to a meeting and about 200 people came. I preached the Gospel. Most of the people listened with a positive attitude. One person received Christ. Later that day we went door to door with Bibles and Bible tracks.

In the evening we went to pray for a sick person and 50 people came there. I preached the Gospel; they listened to God's Word. Most of them did not know anything about Jesus.

There is no grocery store in the village but we got to enjoy the hospitality of the people as we were invited to their homes. Every day someone fed us. When I offered money they got angry.

We met a man at a bus stop. I shared the Gospel with him and he asked me one question. He told me that he is against the Bible and Jesus. He had seen the cross in his dream. I replied from Acts 9 how God changed Paul's life. That man paid our bus fair back to Katmandu. He would like to come and visit us in Katmandu some day.

During these few days we distributed 1000 tracks and 50 New Testaments. I told them I would come back to show the Jesus film. Please pray for open hearts, for an open door to start a Bible study, and for us to be able to visit again.

Pray for our vision that by 2010 we can reach all the 75 districts of Nepal with the Gospel.
