## News from the Field... Guayaquil, Ecuador

Antonio, Silvia's husband and a father of three, volunteered to oversee the renovation of the new building we purchased last October. The work began with strengthening the upstairs walls with support beams, since the walls were developing cracks you could deliver mail through! Antonio lives more than an hour away from the new building and works driving for the province, putting him on the road for countless hours every day. Nevertheless, for three months he was at the church almost daily getting bids, shopping for supplies, arranging for laborers, taking stuff to the dump, and overseeing all labor. Buying supplies here is an art in itself; no Home Depot, no yellow pages; you "simply" cruise around the district and check prices for paint and other supplies. The city has added a degree of difficulty by digging up the street so that no traffic can pass either way. We had quite a deep, water-filled, four-lane ditch in front of the church. All the materials had to come in over piles of rubble, up and down the different levels and over door stoops.

Antonio is also our church treasurer. He transports people to and from services including Chelita, who is wheelchair bound. When his truck pulls out on a Sunday evening, it is overflowing with people.

Fifteen-year-old Fernando came every day to our Vacation Bible School in February, even though it was for children. That weekend he came to our youth group pool party and has not missed a youth meeting ever since. Fernando arrives early to church and helps with Sunday school, setting up for services, Bible Club, running errands and is available for just about anything we can think of to throw his way. He joined the Mime team that performs in the park near his house. His first performance fell on his birthday, but instead of missing the mime he brought his family to the park and all in attendance received Christ.

Gloria volunteers for everything that Antonio doesn't. She and her husband are faithful Bible college students. They lead the youth group. She helps teach women, is in charge of the Bible Club for children and often you can find her sweeping the church or giving the bathroom a good scrub. Gloria is a woman of faith; she receives each message to be exactly what she needs for the moment, and she accomplishes all of her many responsibilities with great grace.

Diane served here as a missionary for a year and a half with her two children until she felt called back to Baltimore. At about the same time, we welcomed Eduardo, Ana Maria and their two daughters back from Baltimore where they attended Bible college. After a seven-year absence, we are thrilled to have them here and they are taking an active role in the ministry.
